About CANVAS

CANVAS, or the Computer And Network Vulnerability Assessment Simulation, is a day-long regional computer security exercise that began in 2007. It is designed to teach college-level students security concepts by providing a hands-on environment to discover vulnerabilities on a "live" system. It is intended to include students of varying levels of ability and background. Teams are composed of students from different schools with different experience levels. Teams use cyber tools to investigate the system in question and write a report of their findings. Prizes are awarded to teams with the best report of vulnerabilities discovered and recommended solutions.
